Earth Day Slime Recipe

Ingredients:

cup of clear washable glue
cup of liquid starch
cup of water
Blue watercolor or food coloring
Green watercolor or food coloring
mixing bowls
Measuring spoons
Measuring cups

Directions

- 1. In the first mixing bowl, mix $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of the clear washable glue with $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of water.
- 2. Add drops of blue watercolor (or food coloring) to the glue and water mixture and mix well until desired color is achieved.
- 3. Add $\frac{1}{2}$ cup of liquid starch to the mixture.
- 4. Stir the mixture thoroughly until all the ingredients are incorporated.
- 5. Use your hands to knead the slime for approximately 2-3 minutes and set aside.
- 6. Repeat steps 1-5 in the second mixing bowl and add green watercolor (or food coloring) to the glue and water mixture until desired color is achieved.
- 7. The slime is now ready to play with! You can mix the two slime colors together to create a fun, Earth-colored slime mixture.

Adult supervision is required for the recipe.

Children should not be allowed to handle the individual ingredients.

Please remember to thoroughly wash your hands after playing with the slime.
